Mark 5:19-20

Small Group Questions -

- 1) St. Francis of Assisi is often credited with the quote; "Preach the Gospel wherever you go and, if necessary, use words." Are the words necessary? Support your stance.
- 2) James told a story about learning not to pour grout down the bathtub drain. What things have you learned in your life by failing? Is evangelism one of those things?
- 3) Do we not feel comfortable sharing our faith because we don't know how? Or we are afraid we will get people more lost? How can we overcome those legitimate concerns?
- 4) Read Ex. 3:10-11. Do we not share our faith because we tend to ask, "Who am I?" (Read Gal. 3:25-26 to discover your identity if you have professed faith in Jesus Christ!)
- 5) Read Matt. 9:9-12. Does the person on your EORO truly need a doctor? Do you regularly engage with other Christ followers who don't need a doctor - but do need a personal trainer and a nutritionist?
- 6) James told the story of Edward Kimball who shared the Gospel with DL Moody (who shared with...who shared with...and eventually Billy Graham became Jesus Christ's limo driver!) Can you play 6 degrees of (insert your name here)? What kind of legacy are you creating by sharing the greatest good news ever?
- 7) Have you ever encountered someone who was peddling "easy believism"? Of someone selling "fire insurance"? What do those two extreme positions miss when sharing the good news of the Gospel message?
- 8) Read Mark 5:19-20. We have suggested that sharing our testimony as we develop relationships with people is a great method for reaching out. Is that your "go to" method? If not, what is your favorite approach when sharing your faith?
